Greetings Farr West Residents,

Progress of the Smith Family Park continues to move at an excellent pace. What originally started out as a concept put forth by the Smith family of Smith & Edwards has now grown into a visibly changing landscape. As you drive by the park you will find that the restrooms and boweries are under construction. The park sign is near completion and will be illuminated soon. The riding arena is also near completion and is waiting to be filled with a custom blend of sand in the hopes of preventing or reducing injuries to both horses and riders using the arena. The playground area and equipment will be installed shortly. Behind the scenes there is continuous negotiation between various contractors and city officials to bring Farr West city a flag ship park that is on or below budget.

## **Upcoming events:**

November 11, 2015 (Veteran's Day)

A small flag-raising ceremony will be held at the Farr West city offices at 9 a.m. The Fremont high school marching band will be visiting to perform Reveille while the flag is raised and the National Anthem once the flag is atop the mast. The flag will be raised by Honor Guard of the Veteran's of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 1481 of Ogden, UT. We invite all Farr West military veterans to attend this ceremony. After the ceremony a small breakfast, courtesy of Annie's and Farr West city, will be available free of charge to those veteran's and significant other that may be in attendance with them.

## November 30, 2015

A tree-lighting ceremony will be held at the Farr West city offices at 6:30 p.m. Choirs from Pioneer elementary, Farr West elementary, and Wahlquist junior high will be there to provide music for those in attendance. After the lights are illuminated hot chocolate and donuts will be available for everyone.

## **General Information:**

As the holiday season and a season of inclement weather approach please remember that the city offices will be closed on Thanksgiving, Black Friday, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

Winter parking restrictions go into effect on December 1<sup>st</sup> and end March 1<sup>st</sup>. Farr West city ordinance 10.04.100.D states that vehicles cannot be parked on a city street between 11 p.m. and 9 a.m. during the winter parking restriction period. Vehicles also cannot be parked in the street, regardless of the time, after a measurable snowfall until the street has been plowed. Our plow drivers work long hours, especially during the night to keep our streets free of snow and ice. Please help us keep your streets safe and minimize the risk of damage to the city's equipment and your vehicles by keeping them off of the road until the streets can be cleared. Please be sure to keep your sidewalks free of snow and please do not plow or throw snow into the streets.
