VETERANS DAY CELEBRATION

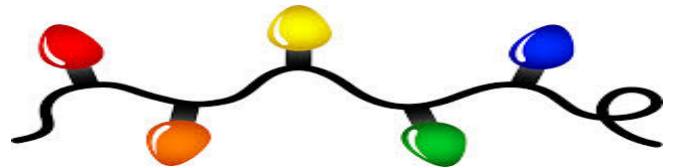
