From Councilman Burkland:

Central Weber Sewer District has voted to maintain the current tax rate for the coming year. This means there will not be a change in billing for services to Farr West City, and therefore no change to the sanitary sewer billing for residents. There are ongoing studies of the treatment processes to achieve the nutrient (nitrates and phosphates) reductions that will be in place at the next state license renewal. It is expected that there will be treatment plant modifications and/or additions to accomplish these reductions, but their scope is mostly unknown at this point.

From Councilman Gwynn:

The open burn period which typically begins on September 15th and runs through October 30th is currently closed. Because of current fire and pollution conditions, opening the burn period will not be re-evaluated until October 1st. While progress is being made on Smith Family Park, we remind residents that the pond is closed to fishing, swimming, or any other activity that disturbs aquatic wildlife, waterfowl, or recently planted vegetation. We anticipate the pond being open to fishing in Spring 2018.
