### Acceptable Items

Please place these items in your Blue Recycling Can.

### \*NOW ACCEPTING ALL HOUSEHOLD PLASTIC CONTAINERS

# 1 through 7\*

Must be marked with a recycling triangle symbol.

**Hint: Empty, Rinse out and Flatten Containers.**

- Soda, Water Bottles; Plastic Milk Cartons
- Laundry Detergent/Bleach Containers
- Plastic Cups/Plates (Clean)
- Plastic 5-Gallon Buckets and Ice Cream Buckets
- Cleaning and Laundry Bottles
- Food and Juice Bottles
- Empty Medication Bottles (Labels Removed or Blackened Out with a marker)
- **Empty** Motor Oil Containers

### CARDBOARD/PASTEBOARD/FIBER -

Must be cut into 2 feet by 2 feet pieces or smaller.

- 12 Pack, 24 Pack Drink Boxes, TV. Dinner Boxes.
- Egg Cartons (Not Styrofoam)
- Cereal Boxes, Frozen Pizza Boxes etc.
- Corrugated Cardboard Boxes
- Kleenex and Food Boxes (Mac & Cheese, etc.)
- Toilet Paper/Paper Towel Rolls
- Frozen Juice Containers
- Milk Cartons, Juice Boxes and Plastic Coated Cartons

### PAPER

- **ALL PAPER Not Contaminated with Food or Grease Stains.**
- Junk Mail, Post Cards, Envelopes (plastic windows O.K.)
- Catalogues, Magazines, Telephone Books, Paperback Books, File Folders and Card Stock.
- Flour/Sugar Bags, Grocery Bags etc.
- Newspapers
- Wrapping Paper

### ALUMINUM & STEEL HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY

- Pop Cans/ Coffee Cans/ Beverage Cans/ Food/ Soup/ Veggie/ Fruit Cans (Can Labels okay)
- Steel nuts and bolts
- Metal Clothes Hangers, Aluminum Plates & Pans,
- Metal Jars & Bottle Lids,
- Small Scraps of Copper, Brass, Aluminum, Tin.
- Empty Aerosol Cans.

### Unacceptable Items

Please place these items in your Garbage Can or dispose of them properly.

### PLASTICS NOT MARKED WITH A RECYCLING TRIANGLE SYMBOL.

- No Bubble Wrap, Cellophane, or Garbage Bags
- No Chunks of Plastic,
- No Plastic Can Holders (6-Pack Holders)
- No Wading Pools or other Bulk Plastics
- No Dry Cleaning Bags, No Garden Hoses
- No Mylar Bags (Potato Chip Etc.)
- No Plastic Bags.

### NO STYROFOAM

- No Styrofoam To-Go Boxes, Coolers or Egg Boxes
- **NO FOOD STAINED MATERIAL!!!!!!**
- No Packing Peanuts or Styrofoam Pellets

### CONTAMINATED PAPER & CARDBOARD

- No Paper Plates or Cups with Food or Grease Stains
- No Wet Or Used Paper Towels/Napkins/Kleenexes
- No Pet Food Bags, No Waxed Cardboard
- No Padded Envelopes, **NO PIZZA BOXES!!!!!!!!!!**

### METAL

- **No Electronics!!!!!!!!!!**
- No Large Items, (Such as Pipe, Chunks of Steel, Car/Engine Parts, Bike Parts, Metal Bars, etc.)
- No Metal Buckets (5-Gallon Cans, Paint Cans or Lids, etc.)
- No Outdoor Furniture or Kids Toys

### MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- **No Glass of Any Kind!!!!!! No Food Waste!!!!!!**
- No Carpet/Carpet Pad, No Light Bulbs.
- No Demolition Material - Boards, Roofing, Concrete
- No Fabric/Material, clothing, shoes, etc.
- No Rubber Materials, **No Medical Waste!!!!!!**
- **No Tires/Wheels, No Batteries, No Chemicals.**
- **No Yard Debris (Branches, Bushes, Grass, Sod, Dirt, Gravel, etc.)**

### DO NOT PLACE BAGGED RECYCLABLES IN THE BLUE CAN!

- **Bagged materials will be considered garbage and will not be picked up. Empty all Plastic Bags!!!!!!**

## **Recycling Pickup Dates**

Please have your cans out the night before to ensure that it will be picked up.  
Cans out on non-recycling weeks will not be picked up.
