

Recommended changes by the Planning Commission to Title 10 of the Municipal Code:

10.04.080: UNLAWFUL PARKING; IMPOUNDMENT:

Previous:

D. Prohibited Times: It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on any public street in the city between October 15 and April 30 between the hours of eleven o'clock (11:00) P.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. the following day. This section shall be enforced continuously throughout all months of the year as to horse trailers, house trailers and the like, vehicles or trucks larger in size than three-quarter (³/₄) ton pickups, or other vehicles of like character.

Change:

D. **[deleted] Winter Parking:** It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on any public street in the city between **[deleted] December 1** and **[deleted] March 1** between the hours of eleven o'clock (11:00) P.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. the following day, **or until the road has been plowed after a measurable snowfall. [deleted]**

Explanation: The prohibited parking on public streets between October 15 and April 30 was intended to accommodate snow removal. A more realistic restricted period for most snow removal would be between December 1 and March 1. The prohibited parking for horse trailers, house trailers, and larger trucks has been addressed by increasing the width available for traffic movement from 10 feet to 20 feet under the Traffic Allowance subsection.

Previous:

F. Traffic Allowance: It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle upon a street in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet (10') of width of the roadway for free movement of vehicular traffic.

Change:

F. Traffic Allowance: It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle upon a street in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than **[deleted] 20 feet [deleted] (20')** of width of the roadway for free movement of vehicular traffic.
