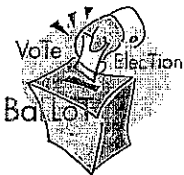

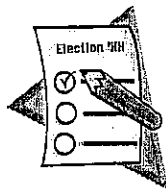

**IMPORTANT!!!** According to new Utah State law, ALL Voters MUST present a valid picture I.D. with your current address in order to vote.

You may register to vote **IN PERSON** at the **County Clerks office** up to 15 days before the election.

## WINTER PARKING

Beginning October 15<sup>th</sup> and continuing until April 30<sup>th</sup>, the winter parking ordinance is in effect. All vehicles are prohibited from parking on the street from 11:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. Deputies will be patrolling the streets of Farr West and ticketing vehicles in violation.
