Typically Weber County provides packets for each of the students. Packets included a 10 page stormwater activity book, Weber County Stormwater Fridge magnet, stormwater book marks and stormwater temporary tattoos. Each year there are several presenters that are related to the water and stormwater industry.

2010

The water fair was held April 22 & 23, 2010. There were 702 4th grade children that attended the fair, 365 boys, 337 Girls. The transportation cost paid by the county was \$85.55 for the Weber School District, and \$384.60 for the Ogden School District. The county provided the packets again this year. The presenters were Weber Basin Water Conservancy District (Water Treatment), Ogden Nature Center and Hawk Watch, Utah State Div. of Natural Resources (Water Safety), NRCS (Farm Bureau), U.S. Forest Service (erosion trailer), Utah State Water Quality (Water Bugs) and Utah State/Weber County Extension Service (Water cycle).

The water fair was held April 27 & 28, 2009. There were 876 4th grade children that attended the fair, 449 boy and 427 girls. The county provided the packets again this year. There were about 7 or 8 presenters.
