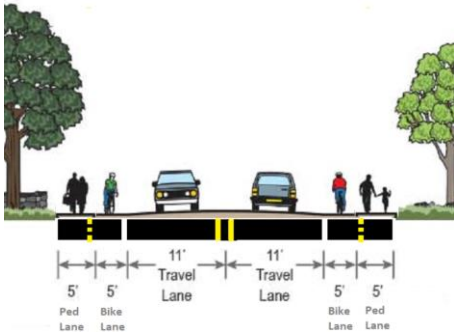


Cottonwood (1900 W) Corridor



BRIEF DESCRIPTION: This corridor is a dead-end road that runs southward from W 1800 N Street. It is bordered on the east side by residential, two businesses, and undeveloped land. The Interstate I-15 easement borders it on the west.

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR TYPE:
Category 3: Unsigned and unmarked shared roadway without a sidewalk

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR USES:
Vehicle, bicycle, pedestrian

CORRIDOR CONNECTIONS: Connects on the north end with W 1800 N Street and dead ends on the south. There is a potential future connection to W Pioneer Road in Marriott-Slaterville.

AREAS OF CONCERN: Currently the road is narrow and unmarked posing a risk to pedestrians and bicyclists. If a future connection were to be made with W Pioneer Road, the road would need to be widened to accommodate the increased traffic. This would also necessitate a marked pedestrian/bicycle lane.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Easy

APPROXIMATE CORRIDOR LENGTH: Total length is 1.0 mile. This would increase to 1.5 miles if a connection were to be made to W Pioneer Road.

RESPONSIBLE ENTITIES: Farr West City

EXISTING CONDITIONS:
Asphalt paved road without curb and gutter
