

Farr West Adopt-A-Park Program

The Adopt-A-Park program provides an opportunity for individuals, families, groups, churches, and other organizations to help maintain, clean, and beautify a park within Farr West City. This program helps maximize the city's parks budget and increases the quality of parks and facilities.

The program volunteers will work with and under the supervision of Farr West City's parks department. The number of volunteers needed depends on the size and requirements of the specific park (to be determined).

Volunteer's responsibilities (these can be customized specific to the park and/or volunteer abilities):

- Clear sidewalks of debris and during the winter, snow and ice (if volunteers have equipment available)
- Clear broken tree branches/limbs
- Pick up trash and litter
- Help plant or remove trees under the supervision of the parks department or other city personnel
- Clean bowery areas and tables
- Report vandalism, unsafe conditions, and/or needed repairs to the city
- Other projects as requested by the city

Equipment

- Volunteers will provide their own equipment (leaf blowers, snow blowers or plows, shovels, rakes, etc.)
- Volunteers may use the garbage cans at the parks for Adopt-A-Park trash disposal needs
- When completing a project requested by or in conjunction with the city, the city will provide any specialized equipment and supplies.

Requirements

- Fill out the Adopt-A-Park Application and Agreement found at farrwestcity.com.
- Commit to volunteer for one year
- Attend park committee meetings as needed for regular communication or direction on special projects. Other meetings dedicated to the Adopt-A-Park program may be held as a substitute.
