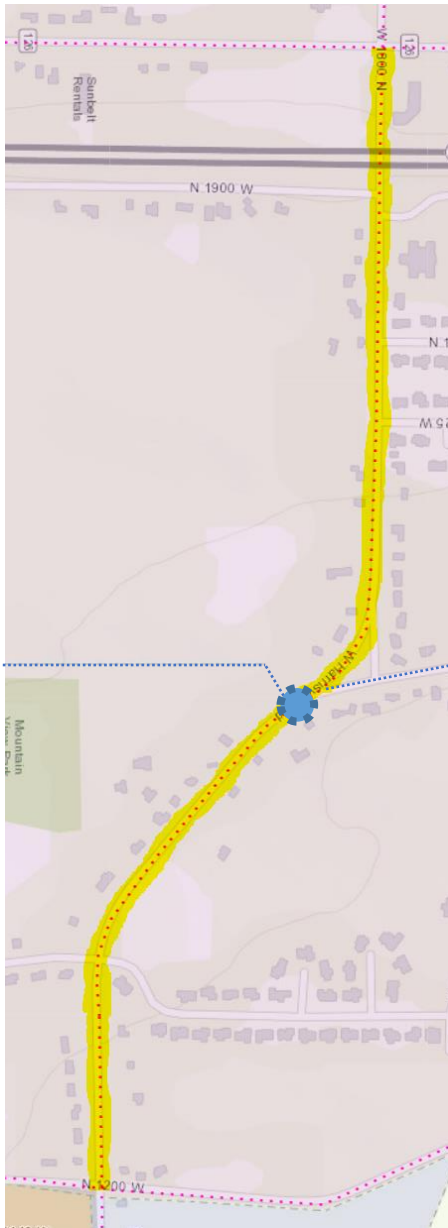


West Harrisville Road Corridor



BRIEF DESCRIPTION: West Harrisville Road begins at Rulon White Blvd. on the east boundary of Farr West and continues westward to 2000 West Street (State Highway 126). Land use along the route is primarily residential with some agriculture.

This also implements a corridor identified in the WFRM Regional Transportation Plan.

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR TYPE:
Category 2: Buffered Bike Lane

RECOMMENDED CORRIDOR USES: Cars, Marked bike lanes, with sidewalks for pedestrians.

CORRIDOR CONNECTIONS: West Harrisville connects with Rulon White Blvd. on the east and 2000 West Street (State Highway 126) on the west. It also connects with 1200 West Street, Farr West Drive, and the Mountain View Park Path.

AREAS OF CONCERN: Along this corridor where it connects with Farr West Drive and the Mountain View Park Path, there is a need for a safe crossing of this corridor that connects the other two.

LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Easy

APPROXIMATE CORRIDOR LENGTH:
1.1 miles

RESPONSIBLE ENTITIES: Farr West City

EXISTING CONDITIONS: Asphalt paved road with curb, gutter and sidewalk on the entire south side and curb, gutter and sidewalk on portions of the north side.
